

| Card No. | Card Name | Question | Answer |
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| ST29-007 | Tony Tony.Chopper | If this Character is KO'd when my Life is 0, can I use its [On K.O.] effect to add a card from my hand to the top of my Life, but forgo adding a card to my hand from my Life? | No, you cannot. |
| ST29-008 | Nami | If the top card of my Life cards is already face-up, can I still turn 1 card from the top of my Life cards face-up instead of my Character being K.O.d? | No, you cannot. |
| ST29-013 | Rob Lucci | Does the "total of your and your opponent's Life cards" mentioned in this [Trigger] also count the card that triggered the effect? | No, you exclude that card from the Life cards being counted. |
| ST29-014 | Roronoa Zoro | Can [Rush: Character] cards attack an active Character on the turn in which it is played? | No, they cannot. They can only attack rested Characters, as described under the regular attack rules. |
| ST29-014 | Roronoa Zoro | If a [Rush: Character] is played and attacks a character on that turn, can OP14-060 Donquixote Doflamingo's [On Your Opponent's Attack] effect be used to change the target of the attack to your Leader Donquixote Doflamingo? | Yes, it can. |
| ST29-016 | Kizaru!! Compared to Two Years Ago We're a Hundred Times Stronger Now!! | If a character with [Unblockable] attacks a character, can OP14-060 Donquixote Doflamingo's [On Your Opponent's Attack] effect be used to change the target of the attack to your Leader Donquixote Doflamingo? | Yes, it can. Changing the attack's target with an effect is different from using [Blocker] to block. |

Compared to Two Years Ago We're a Hundred Times Stronger Now!! | If a character with [Unblockable] attacks a character, can OP14-060 Donquixote Doflamingo's [On Your Opponent's Attack] effect or EB01-038 Oh Come My Way's [Counter] effect be used to change the target of the attack to a character with [Blocker]? | Yes, it can. Changing the attack's target with an effect is different from using [Blocker] to block. |
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
